Sir/Madam,

In supersession to this Ministry's letter No.U-12012/07/2016-ME.I dated 08.06.2016 and with reference to your fresh compliance/representation submitted in the light of directive dated 13.06.2016 of the Supreme Court Mandated Oversight Committee (OC), I am directed to say that the OC has approved establishment of New Medical College at Mangalore in name & style of **Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences** by Kanachur Islamic Education Trust, Mangalore with an annual intake of **150 MBBS** seats for the academic year 2016-17 subject to submission of the following:

- (i) An affidavit from the Dean/Principal and Chairman of the Trust/Society/University/Company etc. concerned, affirming fulfilment of all deficiencies and statements made in the respective compliance report submitted to MHFW by 22 June 2016.
 - (ii) A bank guarantee in the amount of Rs. 2 crore in favour of MCI, which will be valid for 1 year or until the first renewal assessment, whichever is later. Such bank guarantee will be in addition to the prescribed fee submitted alongwith the application.
2. The OC has also stipulated as follows:-
- (a) OC may direct inspection to verify the compliance submitted by the college and considered by OC, anytime after 30 September 2016.
 - (b) In default of the conditions (i) and (ii) in para 1 above and if the compliances are found incomplete in the inspection to be conducted after 30 September 2016, such college will be debarred from fresh intake of students for 2 years commencing 2017-18.
3. Accordingly a Letter of Permission (LoP) for establishment of New Medical College at Mangalore in name & style of **Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences** by Kanachur Islamic Education Trust, Mangalore with an annual intake of 150 MBBS seats for the academic year 2016-17 u/s 10A of IMC Act, 1956 is hereby issued subject to furnishing documents/Bank Guarantee as per para 1 above alongwith another Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for five years from a Nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI's Regulations 1999 for establishment of new medical college with intake of 150 students in MBBS course within 15 days to this Ministry. In the event of non-submission of the affidavit and Bank Guarantees within the stipulated period, this Letter of Permission shall stand withdrawn.



4. This permission of the Central Government is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to the verification of the achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme and revalidation of performance Bank Guarantee. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed and a formal recognition of the Medical College is granted.
5. The next batch of students in MBBS course for the academic session 2017-18 will be admitted in the college only after obtaining permission of Central Government and fulfilling the conditions of OC stipulated in para 2 of this letter.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the notice of MCI and Central/State Government.
8. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.

ORDER

Subject: Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Mangalore, Karnataka- Confirmation of conditional Letter of Permission and Permission for the admission of student (150 seats) in MBBS Course for the academic year 2017-18.

Whereas in compliance of direction dated 01.08.2017 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P (C) No. 468 of 2017, the Ministry granted a hearing to **Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Mangalore, Karnataka** and reiterated its earlier decision to debar Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Mangalore, Karnataka from admitting students in MBBS Course (150 seats) for two years i.e. 2017-18 & 2018-19 vide its order dated 10.08.2017;

2. Whereas the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (C) No.468/2017 with I.A. No.73463/2017 vide order dated 31.08.2017 directed as under:-

"...We are of the considered opinion that in view of the persistent defaults and shortcomings in the decision making process of the respondents, the petitioner's college/institution ought not to be penalised. Consequently, on an overall view of the materials available on record and balancing all relevant aspects, we are of the considered opinion that the conditional LOP granted to the petitioner's college/institution on 12.09.2016 for the academic year 2016-17 deserves to be confirmed. Having regard to the progression of events, the assertions made by the petitioner in the representations countering the deficiencies alleged, the observations/views expressed by the Oversight Committee in its communication dated 14.05.2017 and the DGHS in the hearing held on 17.01.2017, which considerably dilute/negate the findings with regard to the deficiencies as recorded by the assessors of the MCI in the inspections conducted, we hold that the petitioner's college/institution, as prayed for, is also entitled to LOP for the academic year 2017-18. We order accordingly. However, as the Act and Regulations framed thereunder have been envisioned to attain the highest standards of medical education, we consider it expedient to permit the Central Government/MCI to cause inspection of the petitioner's college/institution in case of genuine necessity and as warranted in law besides adopting other initiatives, as mandated by the Act and Regulations from time to time. In view of this determination, the date of counselling for the admissions to the course involved for the academic year 2017-18 qua the petitioner's college shall stand 30 extended till 05.09.2017. The impugned order dated 10.08.2017 is thus set aside. The writ petition is allowed. We make it clear that the decision rendered and the directions issued are in the singular facts and circumstances of the case. I.A. No. 73463 of 2017 also stands disposed of."



3. Now, therefore, in compliance of the above order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court the Ministry hereby confirms the conditional permission granted to **Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Mangalore, Karnataka** in 2016-17 and permits the College to admit students (150 seats) in MBBS course for the academic year 2017-18;
4. The Next batch of students in 2018-19 with 150 seats will be admitted only after obtaining permission from the Central Government;
5. Admissions made in violation of above conditions will be treated as irregular and action will be taken as per provisions of IMC Act, 1956 and the Regulations made there under;
6. The Central Govt./MCI is at liberty to cause inspection of the College in case of genuine necessity and as warranted in law besides adopting other initiative, as mandated by the Act & Regulations from time to time;





It is to inform you that you and your institution is fully responsible to fulfil and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout the

academic year, as stipulated in Regulation of National Medical Commission (NMC). In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permission of the MARB and the said misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission (NMC) or found during surprise assessment at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is liable, not be considered for recognition of the degree. This letter of permission will be revoked for the current academic year in such exigency arise. Besides, National Medical Commission (NMC) is entitled to take all such measure against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

It is mandatory for the Government medical colleges to contribute 15% of MBBS seats and 50% of Post Graduate Broad Specialities (MD/MS) for All India Quota respectively, to MCC of DGHS for conduction of counselling as per the directions of the Supreme Court.

It is mandatory to develop a website on the medical college/ institution and display all the information of the college, courses offered, faculty available and their experience of the last 5 years, students joined, and affiliating university. To display the hospital services, facilities available and the equipment in each specialty, also showing OP and IP census including births and deaths as per the municipal/ Govt. records.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Show Cause Notice dated **14.05.2025** was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

1. Twelve (12) out of Twenty (20) departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.
2. As per declaration form submitted by College following deficiency at different level noted in all departments. Professor - None
Associate Professor - Community Medicine, Ophthalmology
Assistant Professor - Anatomy, Physiology Tutor/Demo+SR - Anaesthesiology
3. Blood bank license expired recently.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

1. Declaration still deficiency found in anatomy and forensic departments.
2. Blood bank license still expired.

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report(ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory. **To discuss the persisting deficiencies in your College, a meeting between the Dean/ Principal of your College and Expert Sub-Committee was convened at the Commission on 01.07. 2025**, in the process for granting Annual Renewal of MBBS seats as per MSMER Regulation 2023 for the AY 2025–26.

5. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and **decided to grant conditional renewal of 200 UG (MBBS) seats** for the academic year 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.**

6. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations.

7. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.
