Subject:-Issuance of LOI (Letter of Intent) in respect of your application/scheme vide ref no. KIET/NCISM/003/2024-25, dated 20.01.2024 received for seeking permission from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian system of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine to establish new Ayurvedic Medical college in the name of Kanachur Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Natekal Deralakatte PO, Mangalore Karnataka- 575018(AYU0890) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2025-26, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under-reg.

Sir/Madam,

- I am to refer to the application/scheme vide ref no. KIET/NCISM/003/2024-25, dated 20.01.2024 received from The Chairman, Kanachur Islamic Education Trust (R) University Road, Natekal, Deralakatte PO, Mangalore Karnataka- 575018, for seeking permission of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to establish a new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of Kanachur Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Natekal Deralakatte PO, Mangalore Karnataka-575018(AYU0890) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2025-26, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and to verify the physical and other infrastructure facilities available, the college was visited on 22.05.2025 and 23.05.2025 in hybrid mode by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the, Chapter VIII "Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- 3. The assessment report was duly placed in the 128th Board Meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 24.06.2025 and Board observed that the college meets the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of Letter of Intent (LOI) as per the concerned Act and Regulations. Hence, the Board decided to issue the Letter of Intent (LOI) in accordance with Regulation 62 (2) of Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges Ayurveda 2024 to establish new Ayurvedic Medical College with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

- 4. Therefore, Letter of Intent (LOI) is issued to the Chairman, Kanachur Islamic Education Trust (R) University Road, Natekal, Deralakatte PO, Mangalore Karnataka- 575018 to establish new Ayurvedic Medical College in the name of Kanachur Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Natekal Deralakatte PO, Mangalore Karnataka- 575018(AYU0890) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course as per 62 (2) of Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges Ayurveda 2024 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2025-26 and relevant regulations there under, subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP) for the academic session 2025-26, failing which the Letter of Permission (LOP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LOI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made there under should be fulfilled,
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.

- 5. The applicant is also need to submit the requisite fixed security deposit as specified under Regulation (59)(6) of notified Regulations namely the "Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024" on demand before issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP).
- The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted in the UG course till the formal permission i.e. Letter of Permission (LOP) is granted.
- 7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 8. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) will visit the college virtually, or in hybrid mode to verify the compliance/ fulfillment of the above conditions by the applicant before considering for issuance / non issuance of Letter of Permission.
- 9. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.
- 10. As per Regulation 9 of MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations 2024 it is mandatory to implement the AEBAS and copies of the circulars dated 09.05.2024 and 06.09.2024 are enclosed for reference and process of implementation shall be completed before issuance of LOP.
